- Eliza Doolittle: (20-30) Female. A flower girl who sells flowers outside Covent Garden; headstrong, and determined to become a lady. Dialect: Cockney, Standard British.
- Henry Higgins: (35-60) Male. A world famous phonetics professor from the British upper class, who is very conceited, arrogant, and full of himself. Dialect: Standard British.
- Colonel Pickering: (50-70) Male. A retired British officer who is very kind, caring and stands up for Eliza, is also friends with Henry Higgins. Dialect: Standard British.
- Freddy Eynsford-Hill: (20-30) Male. A young man from the upper class who falls in love with Eliza. Dialect: Standard British.
- Alfred P. Doolittle: (50-70) Male. Eliza's father who is constantly drinking and uses his charm to get money from people including his daughter. Dialect: Cockney
- Mrs. Higgins: (60-80) Female. Henry's mother, who is very wealthy and of the upper class, is often very critical about her son and his behavior. Dialect: Standard British.
- Professor Zoltan Karpathy: (20-40) Male. A very confident and proud Hungarian phonetics professor and former student of Henry.
- Mrs. Pearce: (40-60) Female. Henry's housekeeper who looks after Eliza.
- Ensemble: (Any age) Any gender.
